

Incandescent bulbs similar to those now available in Elfa electronics.

They have a color temperature of 2200°C as opposed to the usual 2700°C bulbs. They emit a slightly more yellowish light.

You can get them at 25W and 40W, and are available in E27 and E14.

Their shelf life is at least 5000 hours, while the regular bulbs are only allowed by law to last for 1000 hours.

The lamps can withstand a temperature of 300°C, so they can be placed in an oven.

I have had two that have broken in the bonding between the glass and the base and one where the filament was not properly clamped in the holder.

The lights work equally well with AC and DC.

Of course, it costs a little more in electricity than energy-efficient lamps and LEDs, but on the other hand, the color tone is cleaner, they do not blink and they do not provide RF (Radio Frequency).
